 - Describe the opportunities for upward mobility and professional development/training for female employees women provided supported by the Nominee.
 - Describe, if applicable, the Nominee's contributions to develop flexible dependent care policies for all employees, equitable employee benefits for all genders, equitable pay and pay evaluation systems, and equitable organizational structures.
 - Describe the employee benefits offered by the Nominee. Are they equitable for both genders?
 - Describe the Nominee's job evaluation system. Does it promote equitable pay for all employees, regardless of gender?
 - Describe the Nominee's efforts to enter into business/school partnerships to provide resources, training or expertise to schools.
 - Describe the hierarchical structure of the Nominee's company and provide the number of employees by gender at each level of the organization.
 - Describe how the Nominee handles issues of discrimination for women and other minority groups.
 - Describe the Nominee's work in community programs that support the BPW/Colorado and BPW/USA Legislative platforms.
